

BLUE 2 ENTRANCE

Getting to Your Entrance

Your gate entrance will **open at 8:00pm** and **close at 10:30pm**. Please ensure you arrive in plenty of time before your entrance closes. To access the **Blue 2** entrance, you must arrive via **Charing Cross** or **Embankment Station** as other routes will be restricted or closed, and this may lead to a delay in your arrival.

Road and footpath closures will be in place across central London from 2pm on the 31 of December. You should plan to use the Underground and National Rail services to reach Charing Cross or Embankment Station and the Blue 2 entrance. Start planning your journey using the [TfL](https://www.tfl.gov.uk) and [National Rail](https://www.nationalrail.gov.uk) websites.

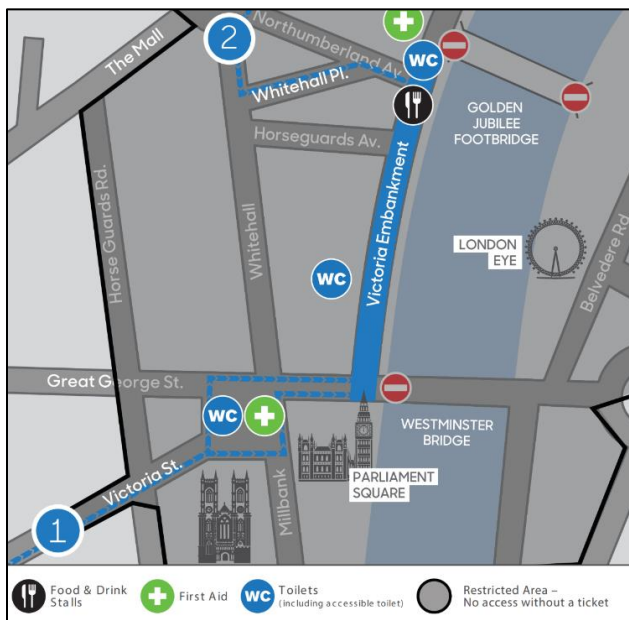
Mainline and Underground:
Southern or Southeastern,
Bakerloo, Northern, Circle,
District Lines.

Walking directions: Exit Embankment Station onto Villiers St and continue straight until you reach the Strand. Turn LEFT onto the Strand towards Trafalgar Square. At Trafalgar Square take the 2nd exit onto Whitehall and walk until you reach the stewarded Blue 2 Entrance.

Walking directions: Exit Charing Cross Station onto the Strand, turn LEFT towards Trafalgar Square. At Trafalgar Square take the 2nd exit onto Whitehall and walk until you reach the stewarded Blue 2 Entrance.

Be sure to observe instructions from stewards and signage from the station exit.
